Indigenous Perspectives

Walking with Respect: Honoring Indigenous Roots in Brandon.
As autumn settles over Brandon, we are reminded of the connection between the land and the people who have cared for it for thousands of years. This region sits on Treaty 2 Territory, the traditional lands of the Anishinaabe, Cree, Oji-Cree, Dakota, and Dene peoples, and the homeland of the Métis Nation.

For Indigenous communities, the changing seasons are more than just weather—they are teachings. Fall is a time to give thanks, to harvest, and to prepare for the winter ahead. It's also a time to reflect on our responsibilities to the land, to each other, and to the generations yet to come. The land is sacred. It is not something we own, but something we belong to. Every tree, river, and animal has a spirit and a role in the circle of life. This perspective encourages us to live in balance, to listen to the wisdom of Elders, and to walk gently on the Earth. As students and educators, we have an opportunity to learn from these teachings. Whether it's through sitting with an elder or knowledge keeper, taking part in Orange Shirt Day, National Indigenous Peoples Day, attending a local powwow, or simply learning about the history of Treaty 2, we can all take steps toward reconciliation and understanding.

Let this season be a time of learning, respect, and connection. The land has stories to tell—are we ready to listen?



Individual Mini Pumpkin Pies



Ingredients

- 30 tart shells
- 2 eggs
- 1 1/2 cups canned pumpkin {or pumpkin pie filling}
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/4 tsp salt
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp nutmeg
- 1/4 tsp ginger
- 1/4 tsp cloves
- 1 1/4 cups evaporated milk
- Whipped Topping

Instructions

- In a large bowl, beat the eggs with a whisk. Add the remaining ingredients and blend until mixed.
- Spread out the tart shells onto a cookie sheet, you might need two.
- Using a 1/4 measuring cup, spoon the pumpkin filling into each tart shell. I find the perfect amount for each shell to be just a little less than 1/4 cup, so it's a good way to keep them even and ensure you have enough filling for the shells.
- Bake at 375F for about 30 minutes or until crust starts to golden.
- Let cool and dollop whipped topping onto each with a sprinkle of cinnamon. OR, freeze them once cooled {in an airtight container} and take them out to enjoy as needed.
