- Continue to demonstrate the safe and proper use of the various tools of haircutting
- Identify the reference points, angles and elevations required to perform various haircuts at an intermediate level
- Perform various haircuts including use of texture tools, razors, etc.
- Introduction to clipper cutting including using guards
- Perform a clipper cut on model with neck shave
- Students will demonstrate various styles using styling aids and styling tools at an intermediate level
- Students will continue to demonstrate the appropriate personal and public sanitation, health and safety practices as applied in a salon
