- Since the registrations in the spring, George Fitton School has had 32 new registrations enter and 9 students leave for net plus of 23 students. This brings George Fitton Kindergarten size to 53 students in catchment. We are requesting a third Kindergarten teacher to change class sizes from 26/27 to 17/18/18. George Fitton does have the space to make this happen within the building. This money would come from the accumulated surplus if approved by the Board.

Recommendation:

That the Division add 1.0 FTE Teacher to address enrolment growth, this position in the amount of \$105,050 is to be funded through the Operating Fund Accumulated Surplus.
