OVERNIGHT OATS



Ingredients:

- 1/2 cup rolled oats
- 1/2 cup milk of choice

Add Ins:

- 1/4 cup non-fat greek yogurt
- 1 tbsp chia seeds
- 1 tbsp sweetener (honey or maple syrup)
- 1/4 tsp vanilla extract

Optional Add-ins:

- Strawberries
- Blueberries
- Peanut Butter
- Apples (diced)
- Cinnamon
- Banana (sliced)
- Nutella
- Hazelnuts (crushed)
- Almonds (chopped)
- Lemon zest
- Chocolate chips

Directions:

- Put all ingredients into a large glass container and mix until combined.
- Cover the glass container with a lid or plastic wrap. Place in the refrigerator for at least 2 hours or overnight. Toppings can be added the night before or immediately before serving.
- Uncover and enjoy from the glass container the next day. Thin with a little more milk or water, if desired.
