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Course Description: This course is designed to encourage the continued growth and development of the student artist through **foundational art experiences**, with a specific emphasis on the **principles of art, art history** and a **variety of media and techniques**.

General Learning Outcomes:

Making - Art Language and Practices: The student demonstrates understanding of and facility with the visual art elements, principles, and media. In Grade 10, the focus will be on the principles of art: balance, contrast, emphasis, movement, rhythm, proportion, pattern, unity/harmony, variety and repetition

Creating – Artmaking: The student individually and collaboratively generates, develops, and communicates ideas in the process of creating visual art for a variety of purposes and audiences.

Connecting – Art in context: The student connects the visual art to contexts of time, place, and community, and develops understandings of how art reflects, sustains and transforms culture and identity.

Responding - Valuing Artistic Experience: The student perceives, analyzes, constructs and shares meanings in response to art experiences.
