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Course Description:

In this first painting course students will be focusing on colour. The class will explore how to generate hundreds of hues starting with very few essential colours. Students will be working on canvas, board, and watercolor paper, exploring with several techniques using gouache, watercolor, and acrylics. Each student will have the opportunity to enhance their skills and get comfortable mixing and applying the paints with a variety of methods.

This course is designed to encourage the continued growth and development of the student artist through Painting and practicing **Colour Theory**, with a specific emphasis on the **Primary, Secondary and Tertiary** Colours, Tint, Tone and Shade, Complimentary colours, analogous Colours and Triadic Colour Schemes.

General Learning Outcomes:

Making - Art Language and Practices: The student demonstrates understanding of and facility with Colour Theory.

Creating – Artmaking: The student individually and collaboratively generates, develops, and communicates ideas in the process of creating strong colour compositions for various audiences.

Connecting – Art in context: The student connects the painting to contexts of time, place, and community, and develops understandings of how painting in art reflects, sustains and transforms culture and identity.

Responding - Valuing Artistic Experience: The student perceives, analyzes, constructs and shares meanings in response to painting experiences.
