2 Hour Buns

Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 cups warm water
- 2 Tbsp sugar
- 3 Tbsp oil
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 4 tsp yeast
- 1 egg
- 3 1/2 - 4 cups flour

Directions:

- Mix yeast into 2 cups of flour.
- In a separate bowl whip eggs, sugar, oil, salt, and water.
- Add to flour/yeast mixture. Blend well and then add the rest of the flour.
- Let rise 15 minutes. Punch down. Then let rise for another 15 minutes.
- Punch down. Separate the dough into 12-15 even balls.
- Place on a greased pan and let rise for one hour.
- Bake 350°F for 15-18 minutes.
