Ingredients:

- 3/4 c. butter, softened
- 1 cc sugar
- 1 large egg, room temperature
- 1/4 c. molaššeš
- 2-1H c. all-purpose flour
- 3 H tsp. ground cinnamon
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- 2 tsp. ground ginger
- 1/2 tsp. ground cloves
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- Additional sugar

Directions

- 1. In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy.

 Beat in egg and molasses.

 Combine the flour, ginger, baking soda, cinnamon, cloves and salt; gradually add to the creamed mixture and mix well.
- 2. Roll into 1-1/2-in. balls, then roll in sugar. Place 2 in. apart on ungreased baking sheets.

 Bake at 350° until puffy and lightly browned, 10-12 minutes.

 Remove to wire racks to cool.
