VM Students learn the importance of the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation

On September 30th, schools across Canada observe the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation to honor the children who were sent to residential schools, the survivors, and their families. It's a day to learn about the history and lasting impacts of the residential school system, and to reflect on how we can support reconciliation with Indigenous communities.

This day is also known as Orange Shirt Day, inspired by the story of Phyllis Webstad, a residential school survivor whose orange shirt was taken from her on her first day of school. The orange shirt has become a symbol of the loss of culture and identity experienced by Indigenous children.

At school, we wear orange to show that Every Child Matters. We take time to listen, learn, and think about how we can build a more respectful and inclusive future for everyone.

Ingredients:

- Nonstick cooking spray
- 3 Tablespoons butter
- 1/4 cup pumpkin puree
- 1 10 oz. bag mini marshmallows
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 tsp pumpkin pie spice
- 6 cups rice krispie cereal
- 1/2 cup white chocolate chips, melted, optional

Instructions

- Butter a 9x9 inch pan.
- Spread pumpkin on a stack of paper towels and let it sit for about 5-10 to draw out moisture.
- In a large saucepan melt butter over medium heat stirring often.
- Add pumpkin and continue heating and stir until well mixed.
- Add in marshmallows and vanilla and continue stirring frequently until marshmallows are melted.
- Stir in pumpkin pie spice
- Remove from heat and fold in rice krispies
- Evenly press mixture into prepared pan and allow to cool.
- Melt chocolate chips
- Place in a piping bag and gently drizzle across Rice Krispies treats.
- Allow to cool and cut into squares.
