Brandon School Division believes that structured out-of-school performances for the performing arts programs assist in the development of student skills, and that students benefit from opportunities to perform in front of live audiences in the community.

The Division recognizes that in some instances, alcohol is served at community events. This Administrative Procedure allows teachers of arts programs to request permission for students to perform at community events where alcohol is being served.

This Administrative Procedure **does not** supersede Administrative Procedure 6025 – Illegal Possession and/or Use of Alcohol, Cannabis (Marijuana), Illicit or Non-Medical Use of Drugs and Intoxicating Substances. The intent is to provide opportunity for teachers to highlight performing arts programs by way of student performances in the community, including at events where alcohol is being served.

Procedures:

1. The teacher is responsible for supervising all students who will be performing at the event.
2. All teacher requests must be submitted to the School Leader for approval at least ten (10) days in advance of the requested performance event.
3. The teacher must follow Administrative Procedure 4085 - Off-Site Programs and Activities.
4. The School Leader must notify the Office of the Superintendent/CEO in advance of all approved performances in the community.
